Report of the activity: Tree Plantation Event (At Home Premises)

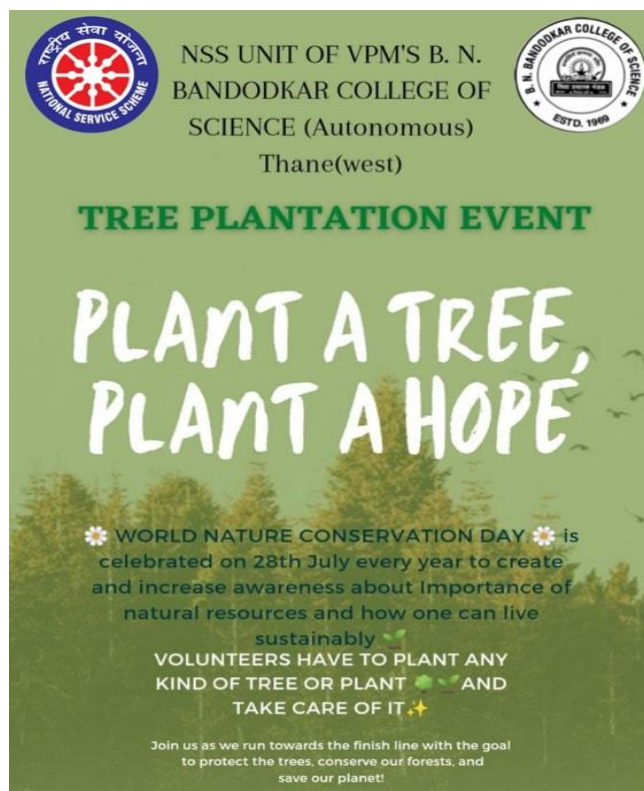
