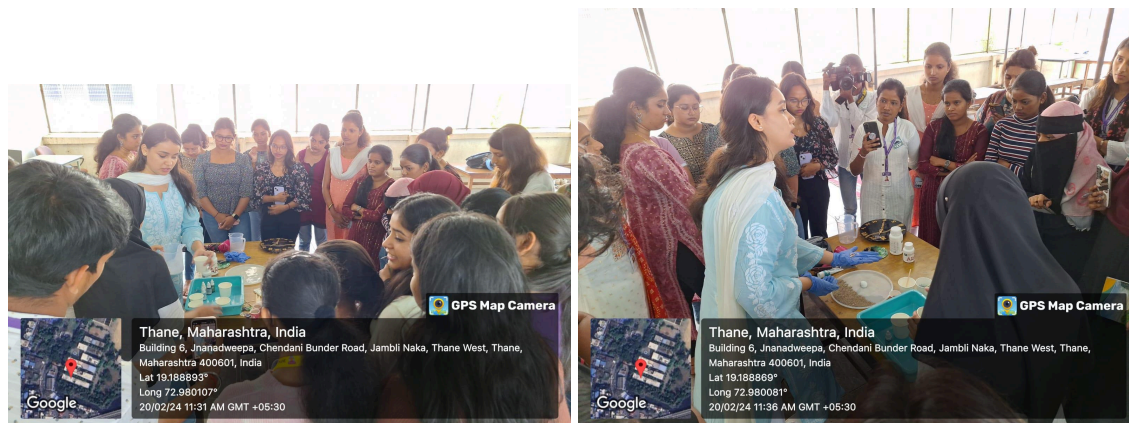
Name of activity	One Day Workshop on Resin Art organised by Nature Club of EvS and BWCM
