The Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) Of the IQAC

Part A

What is the plan of action chalked out by the IQAC in the beginning of the year towards quality enhancement and what is the outcome by the end of the year?

At the beginning of the academic year 2004-2005, we chalked out the plan in QAC and IQAC meetings towards quality enhancement.

- To get academic excellence in College and University Examinations.
- To set own programme to help the failures
- To encourage the students to do creative work and to appreciate such work.
- To arrange lectures or programmes for teachers on role of teachers or quality improvement of teachers.
- To arrange regular meetings of Heads of the Departments and club coordinators.
- To prepare yearly calendar and take it very seriously.
- To encourage staff and students to participate in seminars, workshops, conferences.
- To encourage staff and students to submit research papers.
- To circulate respective science journals in every department.

Based on this we have the following outcome achieved in the academic year.

- We conducted regular meeting of IQAC, QAC, Heads of the Departments and Club Coordinators throughout the year and planned many activities.
- We had our entire year calendar ready in the beginning of the year including examinations, club activities, sports, cultural programmes, HOD meetings, IQAC and QAC meetings, college committee meetings etc. We followed the calendar very strictly to the best possibility. (Copy of the calendar included in the report).
- We found that some students find Mathematics little difficult. Hence we
 introduced a terminal examination for Mathematics in addition to
 preliminary examination for the subject and found that students have
 responded very well.
- We have conducted ATKT Examinations earlier this year, which gave sufficient time to the students to study for ATKT and Term End Examinations. We had very few failures in ATKT Examination.
- Our students from F.Y.J.C. to T.Y.B.Sc. participated in many mini projects through Science Square Activity and submitted the Project Reports. The students also participated in National Seminar conducted in our college and presented the Posters. Our two research students participated in National Workshop and Seminar and presented papers.
- We had ordered additional Science Journals, which will be kept in respective departments.

Most of the programmes chalked out at the beginning of the year could be completed except a lecture or a programme, which was to be arranged for the teachers on role of teachers and quality improvements of teachers.

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Part B:

Q. 1 Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution:

Ans: > Our vision and mission statement is

Vision : Imparting quality education in science.

Mission : To mould students into rational thinkers, competent Workers and socially aware citizens.

To achieve our mission our college has set up various committees and conducted various programmes through them. Following are some programmes conducted in our college in the academic year 2004 - 2005:

- 1. **National Conference** on Human Health and Nutrition: A Biotechnological Approach.
- Campus interviews for placements of Apex Laboratories Ltd, CEAT Limited, L & T InfoTech Ltd., Innovsource Solutions Pvt. Ltd. etc for T.Y.B.Sc. Students.
- Various N.S.S. and N.C.C. Programmes like Tree Plantation, Blood Donation Camp, and workshop by "Akshara" an NGO in Mumbai for development of women, Ganapati Immersion programme, and water conservation programmes along with other NGO Hariyali.
- Through Cultural association "Aakanksha", various cultural activities, workshop, contests like Personality Contest, Rangoli, Photography, fine arts etc. where eminent personalities from industry were invited as judges. Students were also sent for various Inter Collegiate Competitions.
- 5. **Club activities** of various departments in which eminent speakers, scientists were invited.
- College School complex programme where students of nearby schools were invited in our campus to help them in their environment education related activities. Similarly through Science Square mini research projects were done by our students.
- Ten days (24.05.2004 to 04 .06.2004.) N.C.C. camp was conducted in our college.

- 8. **Yoga** Training programmes were conducted for students as well as teaching and non-teaching staff.
- 9. Many excursions were arranged for students. Through excursions students are able to study flora and fauna in their natural habitat. They also become familiar with different types of climates and ecosystems. Excursion develops among the students the feeling of togetherness, obedience, discipline, and ability to adjust and share and in general broaden their vision. It helps to develop healthy and intimate relation between the students and teacher. The students come to know about the diversity in our country and different life styles of countrymen, important movements and national heritage, which makes them proud of our nationality. At the same time they realize the problems faced by the countrymen.

Through all these activities the students gain self-confidence, develop personality, command over the language, stage confidence, boldness, social awareness etc.

Ans: > We have started consortium approach by starting College – School complex, where we invite nearby school children to college campus and help them in their environment education related activities. Teachers of all departments specifically from Zoology, Botany, Chemistry and Physics are contributing this activity. Details of this activity are given in relevant question.

Q. 5 Examination reforms implemented:

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Ans:

In order to sustain quality achieved in past few years in T.Y.B.Sc. (Mathematics) University examination, Department of Mathematics has introduced terminal examination in addition to the preliminary examination for T.Y.B.Sc. (Mathematics) students based on the syllabus taught in the first term.

Mathematics subject is found to be tough by some students, hence for F.Y.B.Sc. and S.Y.B.Sc. Students, those who are weak in Mathematics, the bridge/remedial contact lectures/meetings were held to improve their performance in examination. 46 students of F.Y.B.Sc. and 66 students of S.Y.B.Sc. attended and got the benefit of such facilities.

Generally A.T.K.T. examinations are conducted along with the term-end examination. It was decided in the meetings of the Principal and Vice-Principal with the Heads of the Departments to conduct A.T.K.T examination sufficiently in advance i.e. in the Month of August to enable the students to prepare for both A.T.K.T. and regular Term-end examination. The results obtained were very good where most of the students could clear their subjects.

National Conference:

The Department of Botany had organized UGC Sanctioned 2 day National Conference on "Human Health and Nutrition: A Biotechnological Approach" on December 12 & 13, 2004 sponsored by UGC and Vidya Prasarak Mandal (VPM). Over 150 delegates from 11 states of India made their marks at this conference. There were 44 posters from the fields of health, nutrition and biotechnology. The most colorful part of the conference was inauguration of the 300 pages proceedings on the first day of this conference comprising of 75 full-length papers. The proceedings were in the hands of all delegates before the start of scientific sessions.

One of the important achievements of this conference was the assurance by CFTRI and ICMR scientists to visit the tribal belt of Thane district to identify health and nutritional need of tribal and promises to cater to these using appropriate biotechnological tools.

- Mathematics Exhibition was organized on the occasion of birth anniversary of Dr. Srinivasa Ramanujan, the great Indian Mathematician in the month of December 2004. Twelve teams of students from F.Y.B.Sc., S.Y.B.Sc. and T.Y.B.Sc. Mathematics displayed their exhibits.
- Department of Physics, jointly with Marathi Vidgyan Parishad, Thane Vibhag had organized one-day seminar on "Indian Mathematics" on December 05, 2004. Four resource persons were invited for various topics. (Appendix A). Over 250 delegates had shown their presence for the seminar.



 - > This year 4 students were benefited by Book-Bank facility.


