

Department of Economics

The Department organized the Parent-Teacher meeting on 28th June, 2014. Dr. Sable, Head of the Department of Economics, addressed the parents and students. Members of the department were also introduced to the parents. The parents were made aware of various activities that would be conducted by the department throughout the year. They were briefed about new exam pattern 75:25 and made aware of the importance of the students being present in the class. A brief orientation to the college library was also done.

The Department arranged field visit to Reserve Bank of India (RBI) for the students of TYBA (Economics) on 21st August, 2014. The students visited Monetary Museum at RBI. The students were shown in the CCTV, the process of crushing the solid notes. There was also an interactive session between the students and RBI representatives. The students were also informed about the various examinations conducted by RBI for the recruitment in RBI.

The Department organised the inter-collegiate paper presentation competition for the FY, SY, and TYBA and B.Com students on 30th August, 2014. The students from neighbouring colleges such as Pragati College, Mulund College of Commerce, N.K.T. College, Birla College, S.J.R.S. College, Kalsekar College etc. participated in the event. The students presented papers on various topics such as Monetary Management of RBI, Impact of Inflation on Economic Growth, Impact of Fiscal Policy on Growth, Public

Finance v/s Private Finance, Money Market Reforms in India since 1991, Capital Market Reforms in India since 1991, Management of Non-performing Assets etc. A guest lecture of Dr. Guruprasad Murthi, Director General, BRIMS, was organised on 30th August, 2014 on the topic of Indian Public Finance.

Prelim Examination for the TYBA Economics Students for the Semester -Vth was conducted from 10th October 15 to 17th October 2015.

The 50th A.D. Shroff Memorial Elocution Competition was conducted by the department in co-ordination with the Forum of Free Enterprises on 25th November, 2014. The competition was open to all the degree college students of the college. Participants were allowed to speak for five minutes in English, Hindi or Marathi on any of the subjects such as Role of Youth in Democracy, Economics of Water Conservation, Challenges of Urbanisation, Economic Implications of creating small states and foreign direct investment-issues and challenges. Around 19 students participated in the event. The first prize was Rs. 1250/-, 2nd Prize was Rs. 1000/- and the third Prize was Rs. 750/-. Besides this 2 consolation prizes were also given.

The Department conducted Prelim examination for the TYBA Economics Students for Semester-VIth from 23rd Feb. 15 to 28th Feb. 2015.
