### **Course Details**

- ❖ Japanese language course will be conducted to learn Japanese Language thoroughly from all aspects viz. reading, writing and speaking
- ❖ The course is designed to enable students to prepare for 4 levels of Japanese language examinations namely Japanese language Proficiency Test (JLPT).
- ❖ Each course will be conducted for approximately 6 to 7 months wherein Japanese script writing, reading, conversations, grammar, language structure will be extensively covered
- ❖ The books and other material will come directly from Japan under the advice of a reputed Japanese language school in Tokyo namely “ Ichikawa Nihongo Gakuin” (ING). The teachers will work in coordination and will get benefit of a well known Japanese language teacher .
- ❖ We are initially conducting classes for level 4 which is beginners' level. 24 lessons will be covered in a span of 6 to 7 months.
- ❖ The course material will include textbook with 20 lessons, an audio cassette for each lesson as well as practice questions. Relevant material like vocabulary list, grammar explanation, question sets will be provided.
