"Coastal and Estuarine Habitat Restoration" (23rd September, 2015)

Theme: The Coastal ecosystems viz, Estuaries, backwaters, mangrove forests, sea grass beds, seaweeds and coral reefs contribute considerably to the fertility and productivity of the coastal waters. These are breeding centres and nursery grounds for a number of fishes, prawns and other aquatic fauna. Sincere efforts must be made to protect and restore these ecosystems. The cities of Thane, Kalyan-Dombivli and Mumbai are fortunate to have creeks (Thane) and Estuaries (Ulhas River Estuary and Mahim) alongside. However in past few decades, the anthropogenic activities have polluted them significantly.

Considering the importance of the coastal ecosystems and the need for their, conservation and restoration, we are organizing this National Conference on "Coastal and Estuarine Habitat Restoration" Your active participation and blessings are solicited.

There will be technical sessions on day one in which eminent scientists will elaborate the various issues on coastal habitats and also poster presentation by participants. This will be followed by optional one day field visit to nearby mangroves areas.

About B. N. Badhodkar College

Vidya Prasharak Mandal's B.N. Bandodkar College of Science is the only single faculty college in University of Mumbai located in the heart of Thane city, just beside Thane creek and the 1st Indian Railway line. It has a 13.5 acre lush green campus, "The Jnanadweepa" "The island of knowledge" which it shares with other faculty colleges including Arts, Commerce, Law, Polytechnic and Management. The college offers graduation in 11 Science subjects, post graduation in 7 subjects including by research and Ph.D. facility in 5 subjects. 40 % of the staff of the college is doctorate and 11 Research Guides are working on various basic and applied research aspects and have published over 250 research papers in past 5 years. A Field Station for environmental Studies named after doyen of Indian Film music Padmavibhushan Naushad Ali was inaugurated on 3rd February, 2008 by Late Dr M.S. Kodarkar, an International expert on lake management and the Formal Secretary, Indian Association of aquatic Biologists, Hyderabad. Naushad Ali Sarovar Samvardhini is an outcome of joint venture of Maharashtra State Angling Association (MSAA), Powai, Mumbai and Indian Association of Aquatic Biologists, Hyderabad. It is located on the Powai lake in the premises of MSAA. The field station provides facilities for field work to the students, researchers, NGOs and citizens interested in the environmental issues. Apart from making available literature on environmental aspects like lakes and their conservation, a museum on flora and fauna of Powai lake is planned in future.
